As the zone meet does not have the longer distances for 11-12's, if you chose to swim these events at age groups, you may put down where you did other events to qualify you for the team. We take the times from the age group championships. We want current times. 11-12 year old swimmers should put down where they did the times for the events they enter if they are not from age groups.

Each swimmer travels with the team, has hotel rooms and meals covered, receives a suit, cap, and shirt of some type. (meals on the road are not covered).
